Fighting Heathrow Expansion

The Royal Borough's opposition to a third runway at Heathrow is undiminished despite their High Court challenge to the Government's decision to expand Heathrow being delayed for now.

Lars Swann said, "The Courts have told the Borough that they must wait until after the public consultation has concluded, so this is a delay and not a defeat."

As part of the public consultation the Department for Transport recently held an event at Youth and Community centre.

Lars Swann said, "The event was supposed to give people a chance to learn more about what the proposed expansion of Heathrow Airport would mean for them. I am shocked that key information, such as the proposed flight paths were not presented, and that the local media was excluded from the event."

If elected Lars will join other local Conservatives who are committed to doing all they can to protect residents from the increased noise and disturbance a third runway would bring.

REJECTING THE REMOVAL OF NIGHT TIME FIRE COVER

Lars recognises that securing the Fire Station at Tinkers Lane was a significant victory for local residents and he will continue to advocate for proper Fire Service provision in Windsor. Recently he responded to the consultation covering possible night time closure defending the Tinkers Lane station.

If elected, Lars will join his Conservative colleagues fighting to prevent any downgrade of services in Dedworth.

Whilst talking to local fire crews, it is clear the fierce speed bumps are very challenging for fully-loaded fire engines and Lars welcomes the small pilot to reduce the humps on part of Dedworth Road initiated by Cllrs Nicola Pryer and Hashim Bhatti.
